- A quality holster that completely covers the trigger and is securely attached to a belt, at waist level, passing through at least three pant belt loops. No crossdraw holsters.
- The angle of the holster points muzzle within three feet in front or behind the shooter.
- At least 3 magazines, magazine pouches for two magazines affixed to the belt, and a minimum of 50 rounds of ammunition
- Eye and ear protection

Class size is limited and is available to Shongum Members and non-members. Members include immediate household family of members and probationary members.
